

# Invitation to Tender Notice

Sealed tenders for the following silviculture contract will be received by the Sea to Sky Natural Resource District, 101-4200 Loggers Lane, Squamish, B.C., V8B 0H3, not later than **3:00 PM local time, September 29, 2017** at which time all tenders will be opened in public.

- **BR18LMN200:** Young plantation manual brushing of approximately 69ha of fireweed and other herbaceous brush and 2.5ha of woody brush – Boulder Creek fire, Upper Lillooet River.

Tenders must be submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the tender package.

The lowest priced or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. This solicitation is subject to the *New West Partnership Trade Agreement* (NWPTA), the *Agreement on Internal Trade* (AIT), the *Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America on Government Procurement* (CUSPA), and the *World Trade Organization Agreement on Government Procurement* (GPA).

If the Ministry posts any addendum to the Tender Documents it will be made by issuing an addendum:

- a) where Tender Documents were provided directly by the Ministry to bidders (not obtained from BC Bid<sup>®</sup>), addendum to the Tender Documents will be sent by the Ministry to all registered package holders; or
- b) where Tender Documents were obtained from BC Bid<sup>®</sup>, the Ministry will post any addendum on BC Bid<sup>®</sup>. Bidders are solely responsible to continually monitor the BC Bid<sup>®</sup> website on an ongoing basis to keep themselves informed of any addendum.
