Sealed tenders for the following spring tree planting contract will be received by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development, BC Timber Sales, Stuart-Nechako Business Area, Timber Sales Manager, PO Box 190, 1560 Highway 16 East, Vanderhoof, BC V0J 3A0, not later than 2:00:00 PM local time, November 16, 2017, at which time all tenders will be opened in public.

· PL19TJE007: Planting approximately 335,500 trees on 183.65 ha in the Vanderhoof Natural Resource District. There will be no conducted site viewing.

Tenders must be submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the tender package.

The lowest priced or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. This solicitation is subject to the New West Partnership Trade Agreement (NWPTA), the Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT), the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America on Government Procurement (CUSPA), and the World Trade Organization Agreement on Government Procurement (GPA).

If the Ministry posts any addendum to the Tender Documents it will be made by issuing an addendum:
