Summary Details

The proposed contract requires the planting of approximately 1,423,877 summer trees in various locations across the Mackenzie Natural Resource District. The area of the contract is approximately 975.9 ha and will consist of direct planting.

Contract payment is seedling based. Block areas are by estimate only; overflow blocks will be available for contingency purposes. Planting must be completed no later than August 1, 2023.

Sealed tenders for the following **PL24TGE002 – Summer Tree Planting in the Mackenzie District** Contract will be received by the Timber Sales Manager, BC Timber Sales, Prince George Business Area, 2000 South Ospika Boulevard, Prince George, BC, V2N 4W5, up to **10:00 am (local time) on December 6, 2022**, at which time tender submissions will be opened in private. Late submissions will not be accepted and will be returned to the bidder unopened.

The lowest priced or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.

This Solicitation is using the BCTS Planting Contractor Rating System to evaluate tenders. Please see the 'Information to Bidders' for Tendering Process and 'Frequently Asked Questions and BCTS-Planting Contracting Rating Form' documents for information on the Rating System.

Be aware that BCTS has made changes to its EMS and SFM programs to meet the updated 2022 Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) Forest Management Standard. Changes impacting BCTS clients include new training requirements (Table 008-1, 008-1A, Tailgate Training, SFI Awareness documents, and new Indigenous rights awareness training, as well as changes to training frequency and a new continuing education component). In addition, note changes to EMS/SFM Environmental Field Procedures and Incident Reporting Procedures which occurred June 1, 2022.

Supervisors and workers will need to be familiar with these changes prior to commencement of operations. These documents are posted on our external EMS/SFM website at BC Timber Sales - Business Area Environmental Management System (EMS) and Sustainable Forest Management (SFM) - Province of British Columbia (<https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/industry/forestry/bc-timber-sales/forest-certification/ems-sfm>). As a condition of finalizing any service contracts with the Province, including service contracts arising from procurement processes, those contracts will require that all contractors and their
